FRONT LIVING VS. REAR LIVING

If you are looking for an RV with a little room to cozy up on rainy nights, you may want to consider a floor plan with a front or rear living room. Enjoy a more traditional, home-like feel in the living area and a lovely view from large windows.

PRO OF FRONT & REAR LIVING

The obvious pro of these floor plans is the large space to gather and hang out with family or friends. The position of your living area at the front or rear of your RV means better positioned seating for conversations or movie nights.

Also, rear living floor plans are fairly common in 5th Wheel, Destination Models, and Travel Trailers (as small as 26 feet).

CON OF FRONT & REAR LIVING

One thing that may be considered a con of these floor plans is the limited view at a variety of campgrounds. Carefully consider where you book sites and pay attention to how the site is configured to maximize the view while still reaching your hook-ups!

Additionally, it's important to note that front living floor plans are generally only available in 5th Wheel and Destination Models because of weight distribution.

FRONT BATHROOM VS. REAR BATHROOM

If controlling foot traffic in your RV personal space is important to you, you may want to consider a front or rear bathroom in your layout. Traveling with a large family or lots of friends is fun and the convenience of an easily accessible bathroom makes the trip even better.

PRO OF FRONT & REAR BATHROOMS

Often when the bathroom is situated in the front or rear of your floor plan, you are getting more space and an entrance that isn't directly through your master bedroom, giving you more privacy.

Also, rear bathrooms are available in 5th Wheels and Travel Trailers as small as 19 feet!

CON OF FRONT & REAR BATHROOMS

A front bathroom is only available in 5th wheel models, and features a half bath in the living area. Also, the Large Suite Style bath is usually separated from the main part of the unit by the master bedroom. A rear bathroom may be available in several styles of RVs, but usually forces the bedroom to the front of the unit in the layout.

FRONT KITCHEN VS. REAR KITCHEN

A front or rear kitchen floor plan offers you more counter space, more kitchen storage and often a central living area for entertaining guests while you cook.

CON OF FRONT & REAR KITCHENS

Similar to the front and rear living floor plans, a con is the limited view at a variety of campgrounds. Book sites that maximize your view and still let you reach hook-ups!

BUNKHOUSES

A bunkhouse RV floor plan gives you the flexibility of more sleeping space for a whole family or visiting company. The best news? Bunkhouses come in a variety of RV types, so you can choose a floor plan that fits your budget.

These types of RVs have bunkhouse floor plan options:

- Travel Trailers
- 5th Wheels
- Destination RVs
- Motorhomes

You can also choose the bed configuration that works for you within your bunkhouse floor plan, including dedicated bunks, folding bunks, double bunks, quad bunks, or an entire dedicated bunk room!

PRO & CON OF AN ATTACHED BUNKHOUSE

An attached bunkhouse means that the bed space opens into the main living area, with only a curtain for some privacy. The pro of course is the addition of sleeping space. The con? If you have kids in that space, there is no way to close it off to reduce noise or add privacy.

PRO & CON OF A DEDICATED BUNKHOUSE

A dedicated bunkhouse is its own separate room within your floor plan. The pro of this layout is that you have more space in the bunkhouse – especially if you choose a model with slide-outs – and you have the ability to close it off. The con in this configuration is that you often move up to a longer unit to accommodate a dedicated bunkhouse, while losing room in the common living area in exchange for that precious sleeping space.
